

Information on data protection for the Open Research Knowledge Graph by the German National Library of Science and Technology (TIB)

The Open Research Knowledge Graph (ORKG) is a scholarly infrastructure for FAIR scholarly knowledge freely accessible to everyone via the ORKG service. It enables the machine actionable description of knowledge communicated in the scholarly literature, the curation, processing and reuse of such knowledge.

- Contact you and notify you about changes, e.g. to ORKG content you subscribed to.
- Credit you for ORKG content creation and curation by displaying provenance metadata including your profile name and your activities. This information will be anonymised upon request of deletion of your personal data in the ORKG.
- Link your profile to ORKG Observatories you may be a member of.
- Share metadata about you as a content creator with DataCite e.V. upon DOI-based publication of ORKG comparisons.
