\* For the Alpine Combined event, a 32,36 penalty were added to the time of the best among the non-qualifiers in the Slalom (Ivo Mahlknecht), and for the rest points were calculated according to the time difference of each competitor in these qualifying runs.

These 32,36 points were scored by the one before the last competitor in the finals (Bronislaw Trzebunia).

Namely, the last one (Pedro Klempa) had to hike and have lost half a minute(!). Therefore, it was deemed unfair for the non-qualifiers, (who let's say had a tougher qualifying group) to get a 166,01 points penalty, which was excessively high, comparable to the 40<sup>th</sup> place in other disciplines.
