





DEMOGRAPHIC STATISTICS MALAYSIA FIRST QUARTER 2023

Live births increased 8.9 per cent


- A total of 111,604 live births was recorded in the first quarter 2023, an increase of 8.9 per cent as compared to the first quarter 2022 (102,466 births).
- quarter 2000 First of recorded the highest number births of as compared to the same quarter in the period of 2000 to 2023.

Deaths decreased 11.7 per cent

- A total of 47,767 deaths was recorded for the first quarter 2023, a decrease of 11.7 per cent as compared to the first quarter 2022 (54,123 deaths).
- First quarter of 2022 recorded the highest number of deaths as compared to the same quarter in the period of 2000 to 2023.







Demographic Statistics by State, First Quarter 2023^p, Malaysia

- > Three states with the highest population in the first quarter 2023 were Selangor (21.7%) followed by Johor (12.3%) and Sabah (10.4%).
- Selangor recorded the highest number of live births with 21,148 births (18.9%) while Wilayah Persekutuan Labuan recorded the lowest births with 361 births (0.3%).
- In terms of death, Selangor recorded the highest number with 7,548 deaths (15.8%) while Wilayah Persekutuan Labuan recorded the lowest deaths with 66 deaths (0.1%).
- Selangor recorded the highest number of COVID-19 deaths (31 deaths) while no death was recorded in Kelantan and Wilayah Persekutuan Labuan.
