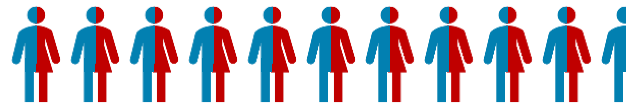

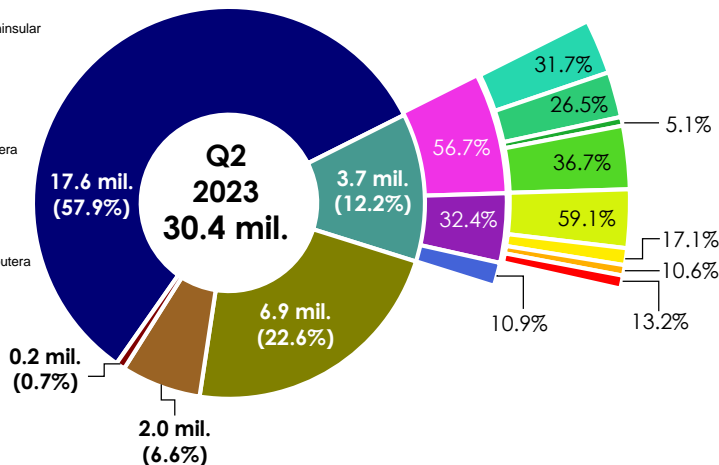

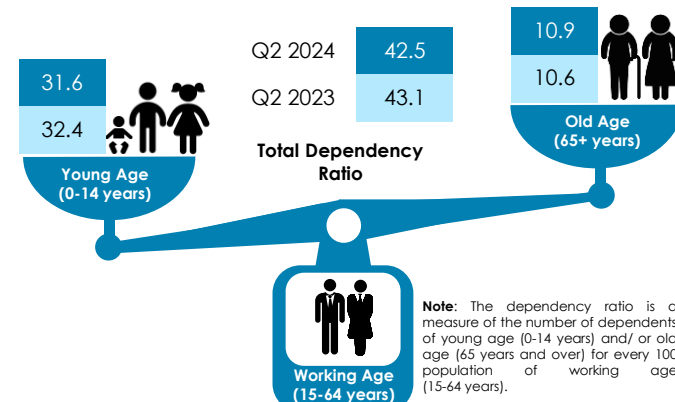

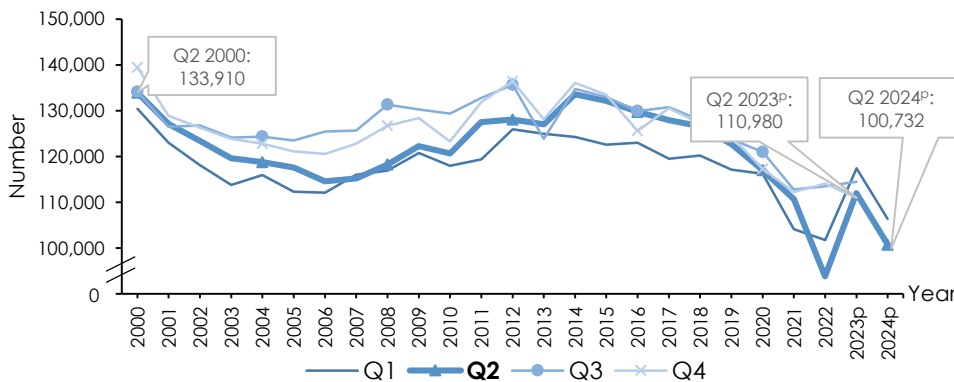

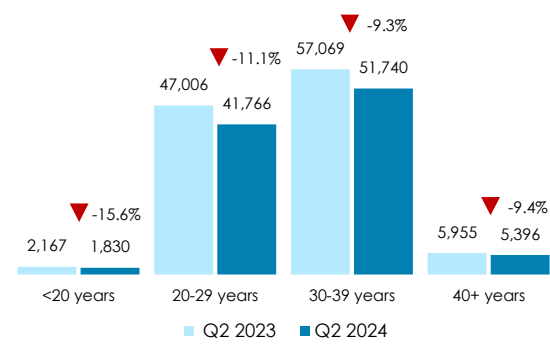
## Live births by quarter, Malaysia, 2000-2024P

- Second quarter of 2000 recorded the highest number of births as compared to the same quarter in the period of 2000 to 2024.

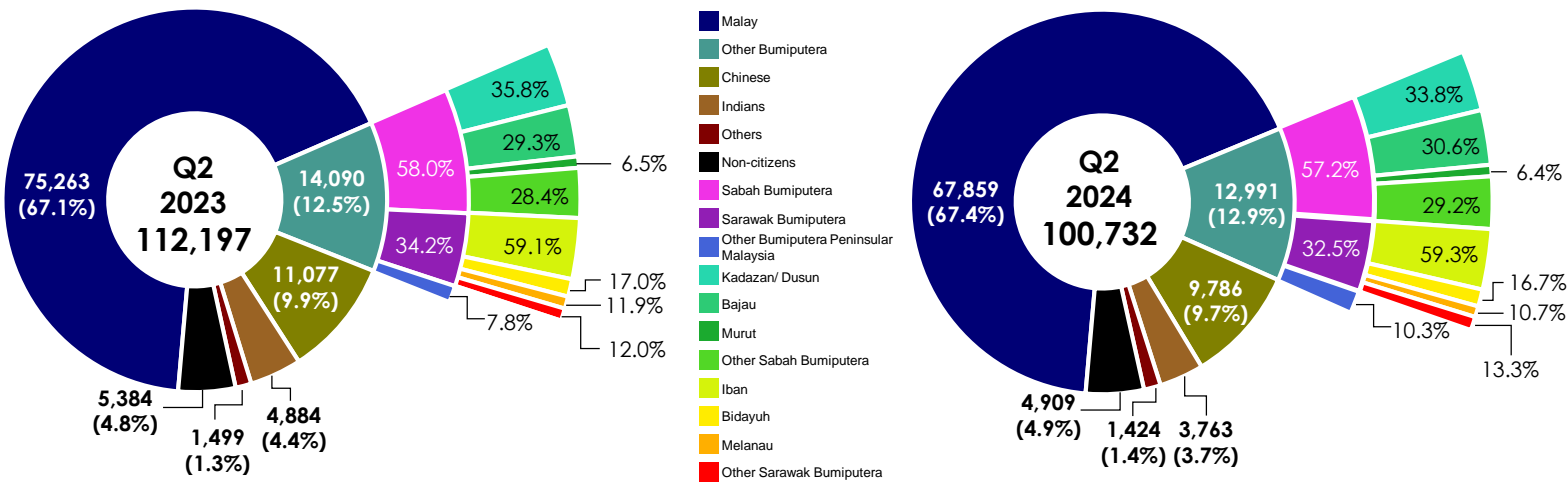

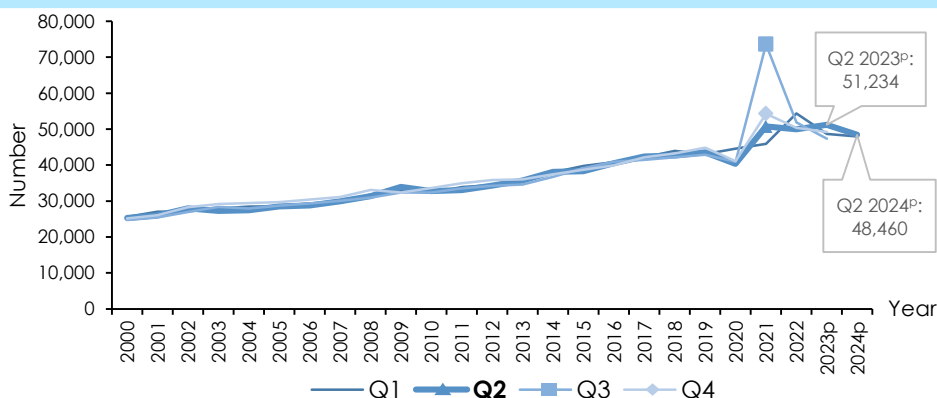

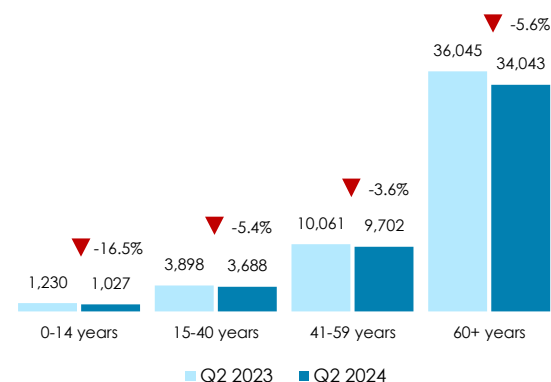

## Deaths by quarter, Malaysia, 2000-2024<sup>P</sup>

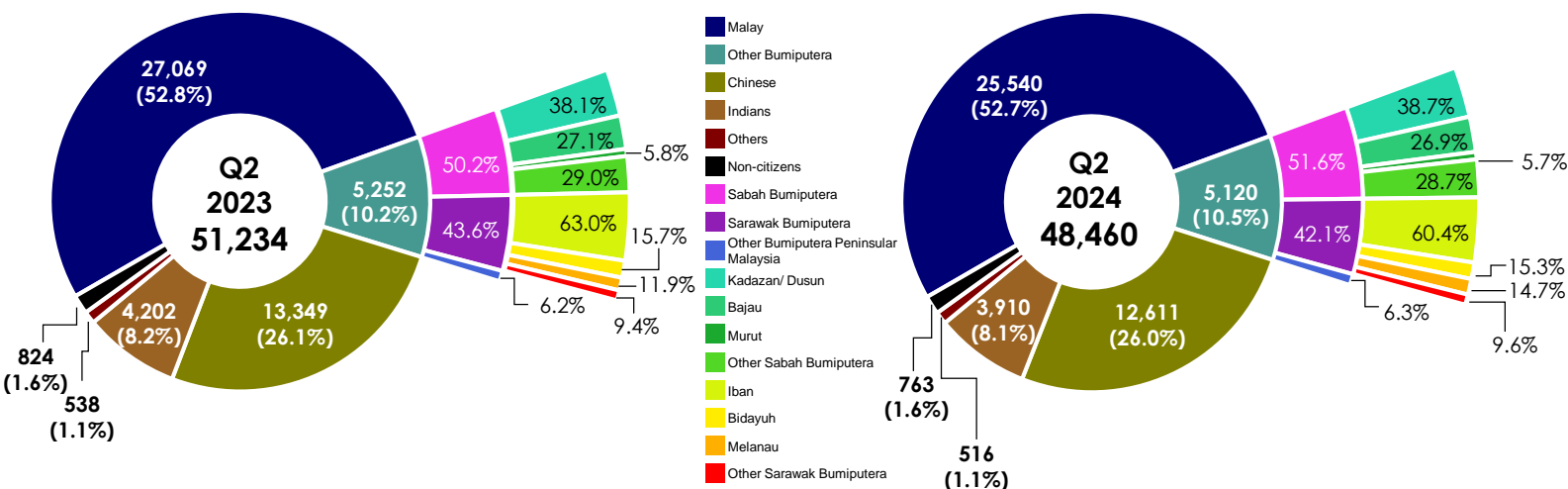

- Second quarter of 2023 recorded the highest number of deaths as compared to the same quarter in the period of 2000 to 2024.



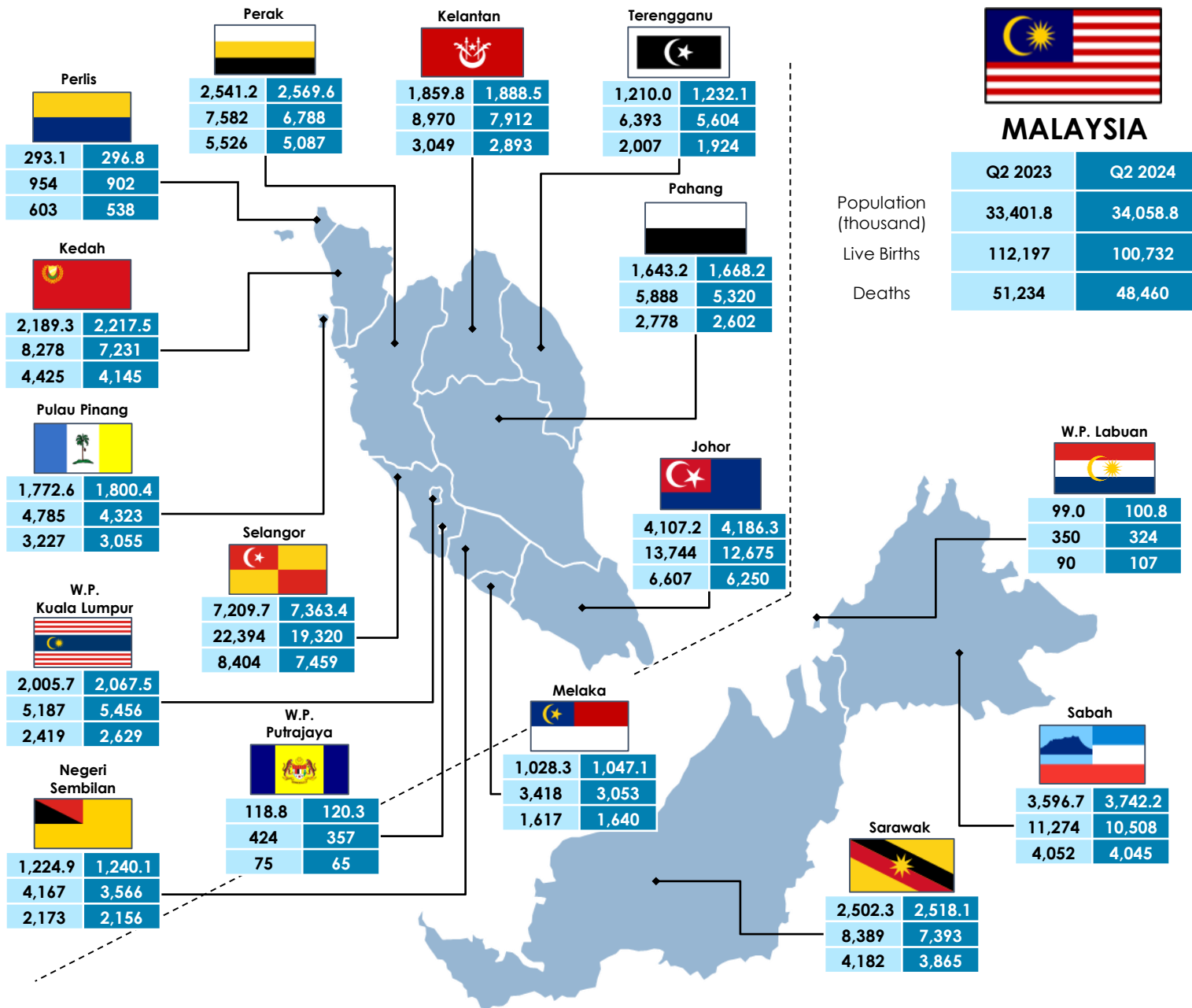
## Age Group

# Demographic Statistics by State, Second Quarter 2024<sup>P</sup>, Malaysia



- Selangor (21.6%), Johor (12.3%) and Sabah (11.0%) recorded high number of population in the second quarter 2024.
- Selangor recorded the highest number of live births with 19,320 births (19.2%) while Wilayah Persekutuan Labuan recorded the lowest births with 324 births (0.3%).
- In terms of death, Selangor recorded the highest number with 7,459 deaths (15.4%) while Wilayah Persekutuan Putrajaya recorded the lowest deaths with 65 deaths (0.1%).
